




Seussian Celebration! - Sunday, March 1, free with Museum Admission

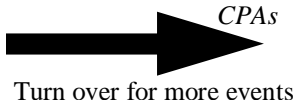
